PERMISSION FOR ERECTING A GREENHOUSE OR POLYTUNNEL ON ALLOTMENTS

- At least 60% of the tenant's total holding must be retained as **open growing space** at all times. Fruit cages are considered open growing space.
- Any structure must be stable and secure, maintained in good repair. It must open onto the plot holder's own plot, must not cast undue shade on neighbouring plots, and must not be located or constructed in such a way as to inconvenience a neighbour. No structures may be constructed within 450mm (18") of the perimeter fence nor within 300mm (12") of common pathways.
- The maximum height for any structure is 2.3m (7.5')
- If a structure is erected after July 2015 that contravenes these processes, the tenant will be instructed to remove it, or the RGS will charge the tenant for the cost of removing it.
- Permission must be sought and received in writing before the structure is installed.

Sketch in shed and any other covered growing space giving dimensions including any area not available for cultivation.
