## PERMISSION FOR ERECTING A SHED OR STORAGE STRUCTURE ON ALLOTMENTS (applies to structures higher than $4 \mathrm{ft} / 1.25 \mathrm{~m}$ )

- At least $60 \%$ of the tenant's total holding must be retained as open growing space at all times. Fruit cages are considered open growing space.
- Any structure must be stable and secure, maintained in good repair. It must open onto the plot holder's own plot, must not cast undue shade on neighbouring plots, and must not be located or constructed in such a way as to inconvenience a neighbour.
- No structures may be constructed within 450 mm (18") of the perimeter fence or within 300 mm (12") of common paths.
- The maximum footprint is $6^{\prime} \times 4^{\prime}(1.8 \mathrm{~m} \times 1.2 \mathrm{~m})$.
- The maximum height for any structure is $2.3 \mathrm{~m}\left(7^{\prime} 6^{\prime \prime}\right)$.
- The structure must be in manageable pieces to be constructed on site.
- If a structure is erected after July 2016 that contravenes these processes, the tenant will be instructed to remove it, or the RGS will charge the tenant for the cost of removing it.
- Permission must be sought and received in writing prior to erecting and shed or storage structure; this includes the replacement of any existing shed or structure
