

SUMMER SHOW – NEW VARIETY 2019 Winners

Section A – Flowers

1. Vase containing 1 HT rose, any colour – **R Linton.**
2. The most fragrant rose in the garden – judged by the visitors – **S Gilbe**
3. *Vase of multiflora roses, 3 stems of any one variety – **M Renshaw**
4. *Bowl of any number of roses arranged for an all-round effect – **M Renshaw**
5. Vase of 6 stems of sweet peas, any 1 variety – **G O'Reilly**
6. Vase of 12 stems of sweet peas, can be mixed varieties – **M Renshaw**
7. Vase or bowl of pansies or violas with own foliage, not more than 12 stems, can be mixed – **C Martinez**
8. *Vase of cut flowers, 3 or more kinds with any foliage, arranged for all round effect - **M Renshaw**
9. *Arrangement in a goblet of flowers and/ or leaves - **M Renshaw**

Section B - Vegetables

10. 3 asparagus spears – **N Ribeux**
11. 6 pods of broad beans – **M Renshaw**
12. Any other vegetable / e.g. courgettes, potatoes – **S Karwatowski**, globe artichokes

13. 12 pods of either pea, mangetout or sugar snap (not mixed) **S Hill** – mangetout
J Savage - Peas
14. a) 3 garlic bulbs – **R Patel**
b) 3 elephant garlic bulbs – no entries
15. 3 sticks of rhubarb (natural) - **C Martinez**
16. A display of 3 different seasonal vegetables that you like in a salad – **V Fowler**

Flower/vegetable/fruit - mixed

- B17. * 1 specimen each of 1 flower, 1 fruit and 1 vegetable – **V Fowler**

Section C – Fruit

18. 15 gooseberries – **S Clark**
19. 15 raspberries, with calyx – no entries
20. 12 strawberries, with calyx – **J & P Crawford**
