RGS Waiting List and how it works

There are currently 395 people on the waiting list. People now being offered plots have been waiting since 2018 and we now suggest that the waiting time is approximately 5 years. Last year only 15 plots were let on Site 3.

Applications come via our website.

- They are added to the **primary waiting list**, and we write to them explaining the long wait and inviting them to join the RGS.
- When they get close to the top we write again, asking them to confirm their details and interest. If they don't reply to the emails or phone calls, they are deleted and should they reapply they start again at the bottom of the list.
- Plots are then allocated in very strict numerical order
- At every stage people are reminded about the **secondary waiting list**. This is for people who have come to the top of the list but 'the time is not right for them' at the time offering a plot. We only keep their name and date of being added to the list for 10 years. They must contact us if they wish to be reinstated towards the top of the primary waiting list.
- Occasionally there are preferences for Site 2 or Site 3, we try to accommodate these requests. It may mean a longer wait.
