Plot Inspections and Cultivation

The weather this year has been very mixed with long dry periods followed by heavy rain. Crops on most plots were good though, especially tomatoes, and the blight held off until the end of the season. Some plot holders still have large grassed areas which is a pity when crops could be grown in lieu.

Foxes continue to damage plots and we ask plot holders to keep sheds closed and rubbish cleared to deter them.

Twenty six letters regarding minor issues were sent out to plot holders following our three plot inspections. One Stage 4 letter was sent out.
