We have had another good year for the Stores. With better weather, slug pellets have been less popular. The large containers of Maxicrop Tomato Fertiliser became unavailable so alternatives have been sourced.

We reorganised the Site 2 Store to improve the access and visibility of the loose products and to make better use of the space.

Regrettably, the company which produced our best seller, Country Natural, closed its doors. Alternatives are being investigated.

We have joined the Thompson and Morgan Group Discount Scheme which has similar benefits to the Dobies Scheme. This will be launched in January when the 2026 brochures will be available.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all the volunteers who help with the Stores, together with Annie Hardinge for looking after the seeds and Georgina O'Reilly for ensuring the tea/coffee station is well stocked.
